Hlinecko Quality



Hlinecko Mead belongs to meads of the highest quality in the Czech Republic. It is produced in a cold way, which means that the essence of both nectar and forest honey is not boiled and all the beneficial substances of honey are kept in the mead. Then special yeast is added and the essence is fermenting for 4-8 weeks in set temperature. After that the essence ripens for 3 months up to 2 years (and more). The mead is made without additional spiriting, dying or conservation substances and sugar. The water used for the mead comes from the Hamry dam. 450 kg of honey is used for 1000 litres of water. The mead is made of nectar and honeydew and it contains 13 per cent of alcohol.

The mead is light brown (the colour which is made when only water and honey are mixed). Alcohol in the mead comes purely from fermented honey. The mead is stabilized by double filtration and guaranteed content of alcohol.

The quality of the mead is standardized in accordance with Czech bills about alcoholic beverages.
