Hlinsko Scarves (Hlinecké šály)





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Scarves made of acrylic yarn – the pattern called twill-weave is created by stripes and squares. Diamond ornaments are created from its derivates. These scarves are made for colder periods of the year.

Scarves made of cotton yarn – basic colour is always white. Scarves are designed to be worn in spring or summer.

The manufacturing process on the loom:

The first and the most important thing is preparation of well-woven warp. At this stage threads in desired number and width are wound on the warp beam. The next step is guiding threads into sheets (harness) and beam. The sheets are wooden frames, inside which heddles are placed on wires. The warp is guided into sheets and then to a beam guide, a steel comb with slits which extend thread. The beam divils threads and thrusts weft to the edge of the fabric. The weft thread crosses the fabric and determines the width.

Steping on treadles 1 and 3 certain threads are lifted, the warp is fed through the gap and treadles 2 and 4 are stepped on. Sheets are switched and threads are turned over. The warp is switched and thrusted by the weft. And the procedure is repeated until the end.

After weaving the fabric is removed from the loom, carefully checked, mistakes are repaired, fringing knots are made on the edge to prevent fraying of threads. Scarves are then washed, dried, ironed and ready to make a new owner happy.



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
